 - i. Denise Zabkiewicz: Data was not presented as we would have liked it to be; ORJ is not equipped to do the full analysis needed for this body; May want to craft a DSA between the SO and ORJ;
 - ii. Jill Ray: There was no clear ask from the presenters;
 - iii. Becky Vichiquis: Suggested writing a letter to city managers with a clear ask;
 - iv. Melissa Klawuhn: SO data is limited to arrests that end up in booking, does not include cite and release; SO wouldn't be verifying other LEAs data; Will seek permission from Sheriff to release data to Burns Institute for analysis;
 - v. Christopher James: Recommended learning the flow of the meeting for future presentations; Presenters need to be well-informed on the topic and process of presentation;

- iii. Denise Zabkiewicz: Recommended developing a table with all agencies we receive data from and how they collect race/ethnicity; What are best practices to record race/ethnicity;

- iv. Melissa Klawuhn: Variety of ways to collect race/ethnicity data; Agencies probably are not tracking how they retrieve that data – RIPA will provide insight into collection;

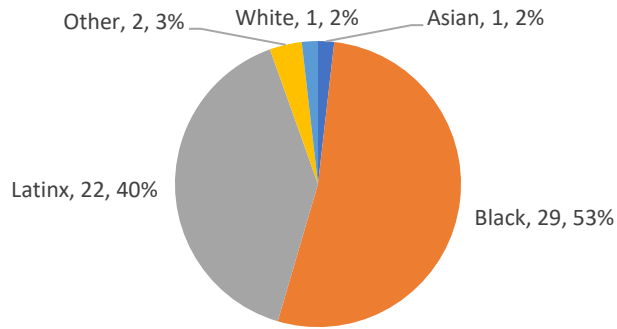

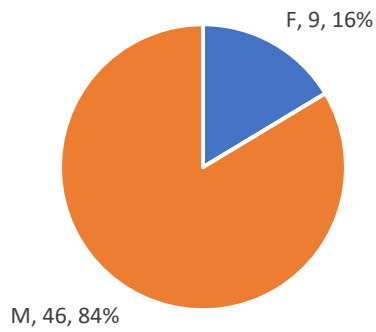

Juvenile Intakes by Race / Ethnicity (Q4 '21 Intakes)



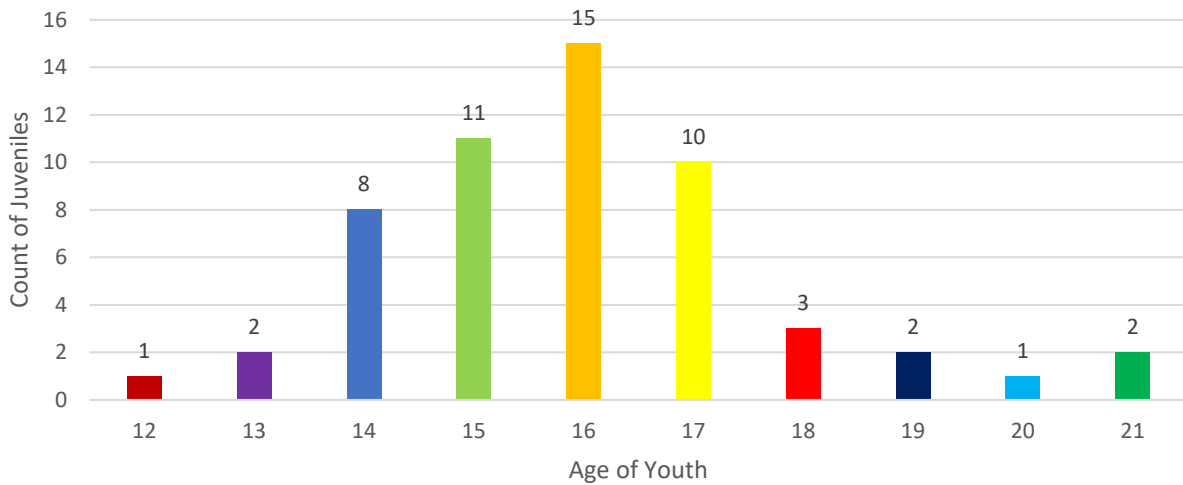

Juvenile Intakes by Sex (Q4 '21 Intakes)

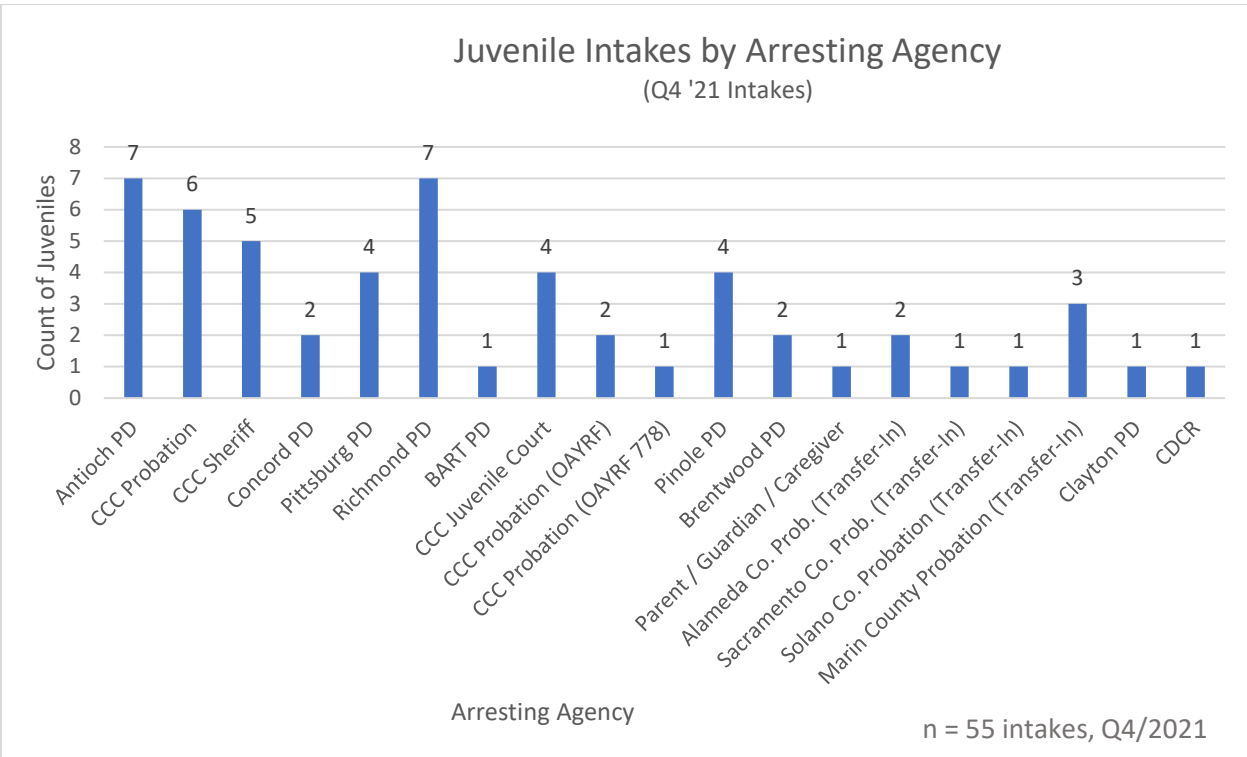
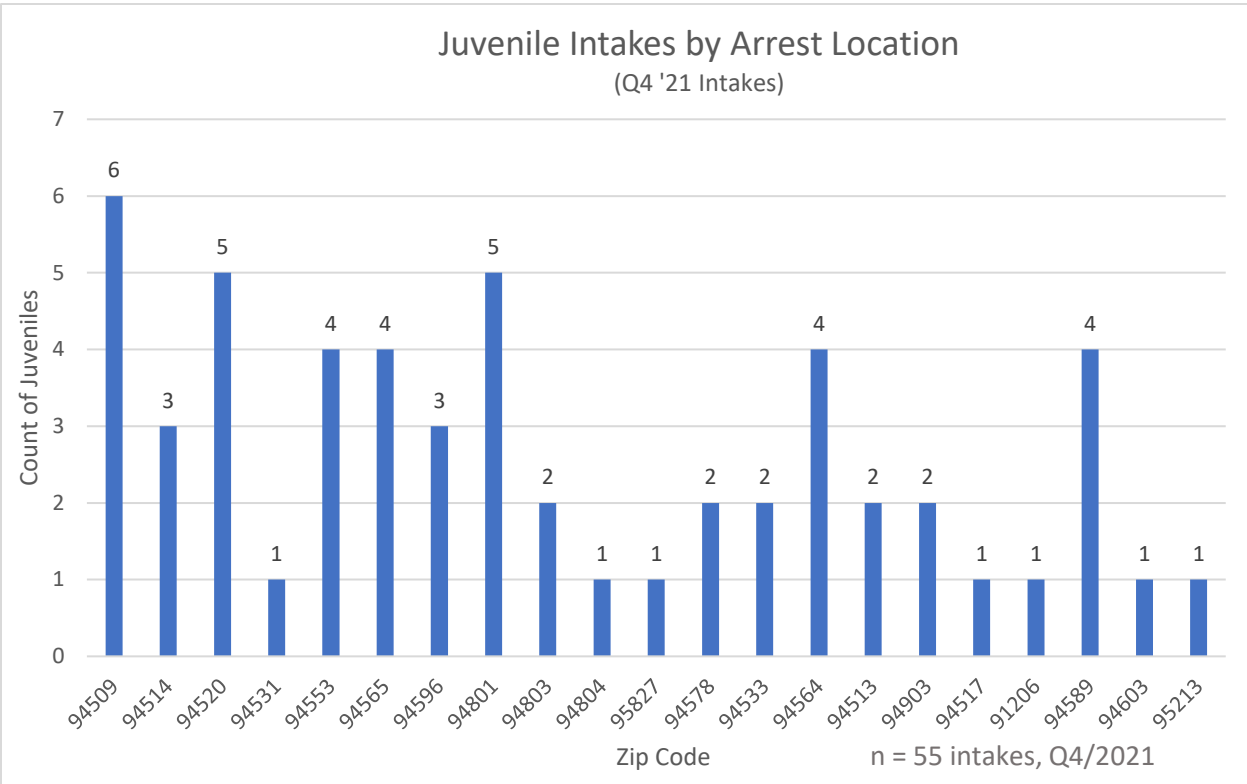

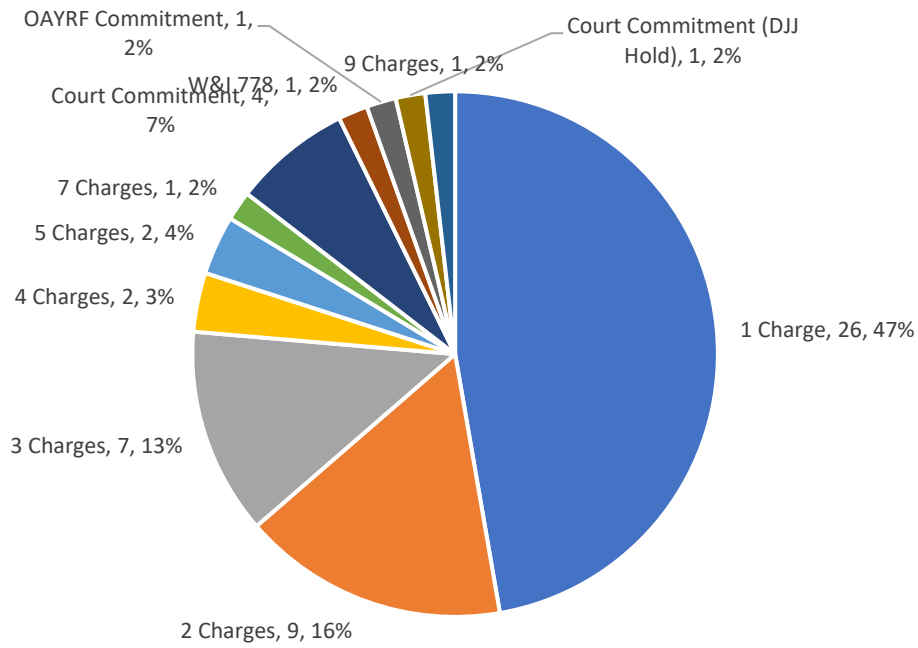
Juvenile Intakes by Age (Q4 '21 Intakes)

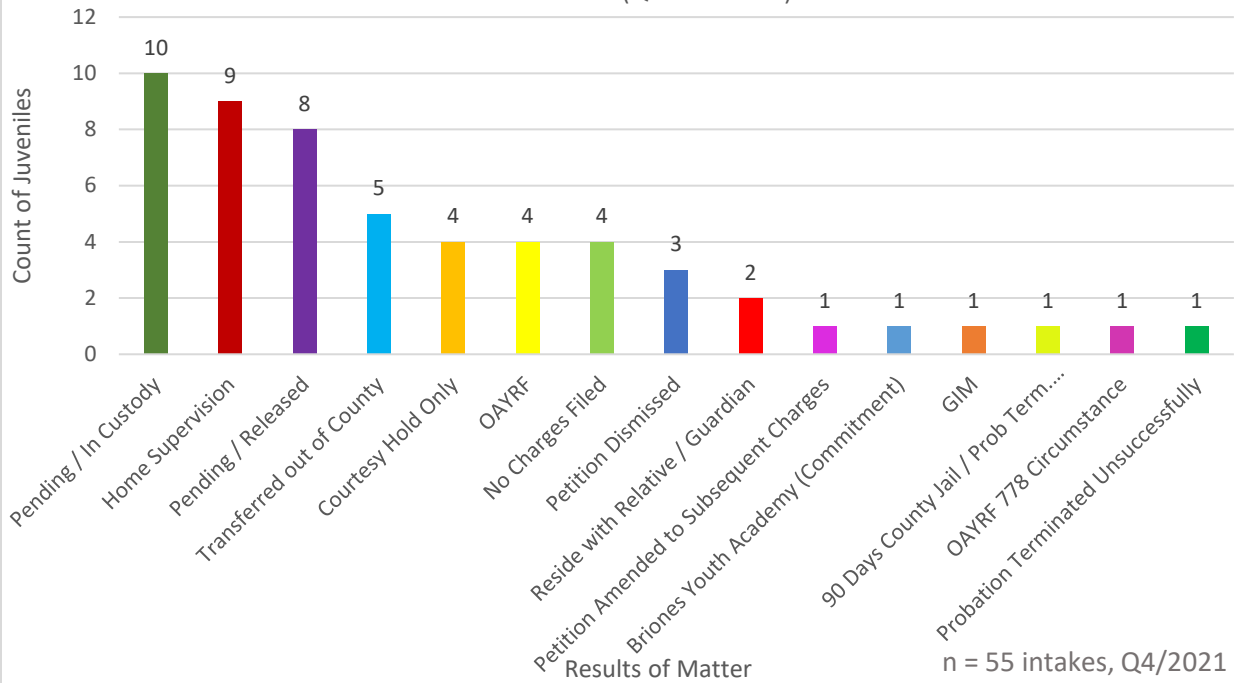
Juvenile Intakes by Number of Offenses (Q4 '21 Intakes)

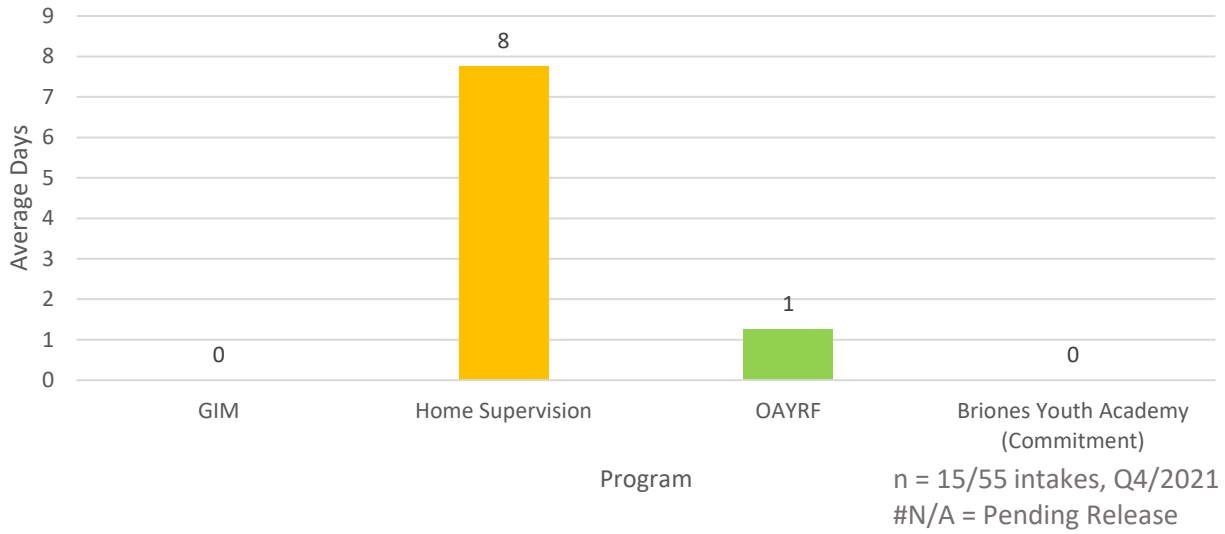

Juvenile Intakes by Results of Matter (Q4 '21 Intakes)

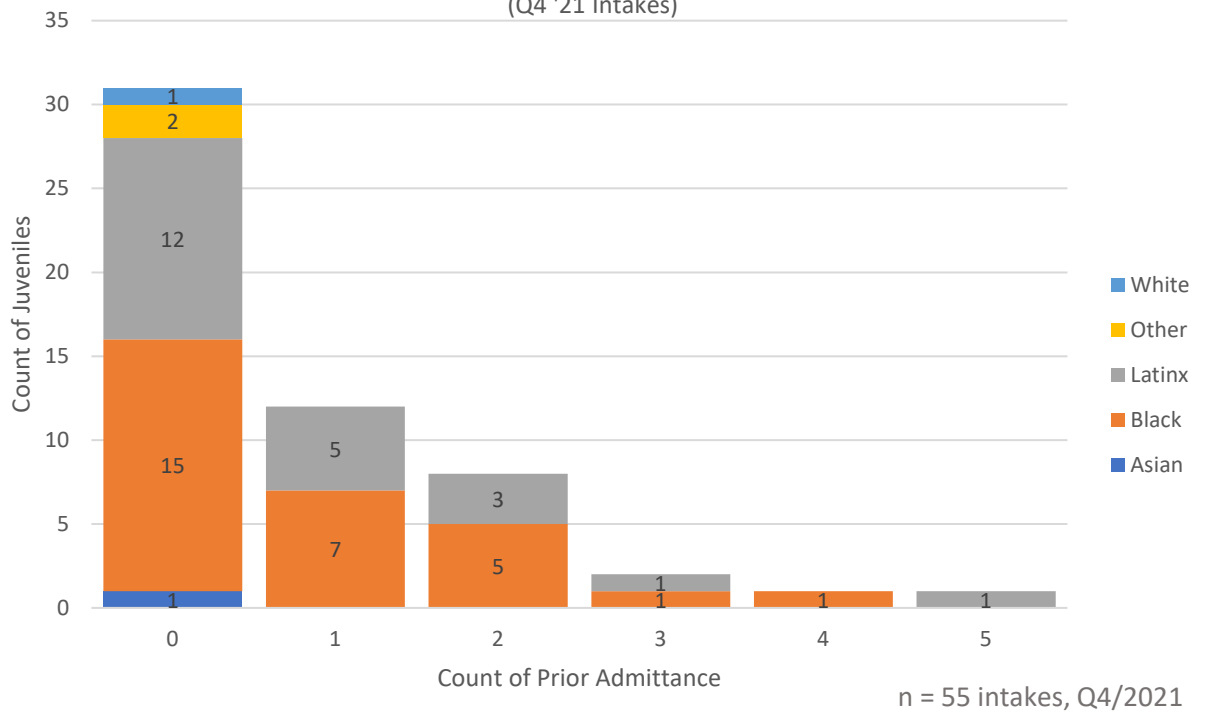
