

CalGreen Construction & Demolition Recycling Requirements for Permitted Projects

Effective January 1, 2017

Below project types must comply with CalGreen Construction Recycling Requirements:

- Prior to issuance of permits, completed and signed Recycling Plans must be submitted.
- Prior to final inspections, a completed Recycling Report with accompanying receipts that demonstrate how **65%** of the material/waste from the project jobsite was reused or recycled must be submitted.

Applies to the following Residential projects:
All Demolition Work requiring Permits
All New Low Rise & High Rise Buildings requiring Permits
All Permitted Additions and Alterations which increase the building's conditioned area, volume, or size OR All Permitted Additions and Alterations which increase or impact at least 5,000 square feet of conditioned & unconditioned building (including reroofing projects)
Applies to the following Non-Residential projects:
All Demolition Work requiring Permits
All New Buildings
All Permitted Additions and Alterations (including reroofing projects)
Recycle 100% of excavated soil & land clearing debris
Construction Documents must list Universal Waste & Final Report must prove proper recycling/disposal (for Nonresidential Additions & Alterations only)
