February 11, 2019, Clayton, CA – Contra Costa County Public Works will conduct slide removal and shoulder repair activities on Marsh Creek Road, between Deer Valley Road and the Clayton City limit.

The repair work will begin today and last through **Monday, February 25th** from **9am** to **4pm** each day, weather permitting. Message boards will be placed at Deer Valley Road and in Clayton, advising motorists of work ahead. Expect delays during the repair work.
