On **Monday, September 12, at 7 pm (PST)** the Veterans' Voices show will host a LIVE panel of experts to help explain the recently passed Promise to Address Comprehensive Toxics (PACT) Act. The show, "**The PACT Act: Unpacked**" will take an in-depth look at the new legislation and what it means to Veterans. The discussion will be hosted by the Contra Costa County Veterans Service Officer Nathan Johnson. Guests will include Dr. Michael Sherman of Contra Costa Oncology and Veterans' Advocate Jim Radogna.
